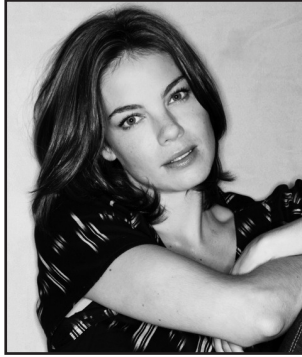


# AN OAK TREE

Michelle then joined Charlize Theron, Frances McDormand, and Sissy Spacek in “North Country” for director Niki Caro. She then starred in “Gone Baby Gone” with Casey Affleck and Morgan Freeman, in “The Heartbreak Kid” opposite Ben Stiller and in “Mission: Impossible III” with Tom Cruise and Philip Seymour Hoffman for director J.J. Abrams.

Most recently Michelle starred opposite Patrick Dempsey in the romantic comedy “Made of Honor” and in the boxoffice hit thriller “Eagle Eye” alongside Shia LaBeouf. Michelle has completed filming roles in Sophia Coppola’s “Somewhere” and “Due Date” starring with Robert Downey Jr. and Zach Galifianakis. On stage, she starred in the play “In Film” directed by Pam McKinnion at New York Stage & Film.
